## Maine

- Residential: Up to \$3,000 residential rebate from [Efficiency Maine](#).
- Commercial: None

## New Hampshire

- Residential: 30% (up to \$6,000) rebate from the [NH Public Utilities Commission](#)
- Commercial: 30% (up to \$50,000) rebate from the [NH Public Utilities Commission](#)
- [Thermal Renewable Energy Credits](#) (most appropriate for larger projects)

## Vermont

- Residential: \$2,000 from [Efficiency VT](#) and up to \$3,000 from the [VT Clean Energy Development Fund](#)
- Commercial: Up to \$60,000 from the [VT Clean Energy Development Fund](#)
- Public-serving non-profits
  - Up to \$80,000 from the [VT Clean Energy Development Fund](#)

- Residential: 45% up to cap of \$10,000 - \$36,000 based on boiler size) from [NYSERDA](#)
- Commercial: 45% up to cap of \$10,000 - \$270,000 based on boiler size from [NYSERDA](#)
